IN MEMORIAM

Dr. Paul F. Brandwein Dr. S. Marie Kuhnen Dr. Harry Miller, Jr. J. Thomas Seely I've been a science educator for more than two decades, teaching college students the finer details of gene expression, while also working with teachers and elementary school students to encourage young people to persist in the science pipeline. In that time, I have discovered two things that are absolutely necessary to engage students in science learning: I) ensure the material is relevant and applicable to their own lives, and 2) provide hands-on opportunities for learning. The challenge of this past year has been that just when science became suddenly relevant in an all-too-real way, those necessary hands-on activities became temporarily inaccessible. The pandemic has highlighted the need for more scientists and scientifically literate citizens, yet science education has suffered.

Students have seen their virtual news feeds become inundated by technical topics such as viral replication and vaccine development, and they are naturally eager to better understand the science behind how COVID-19 has transformed the world around them. What an opportunity to engage the next generation of scientists! As we return to classroom learning and explore ways to fill the achievement gaps widened by the pandemic, it is vital that we

again provide active learning environments where students can experience science firsthand. Your contributions to PEEC help us fulfill that critical mission and to advance environmental education.

PEEC educators are already engaging with summer campers, helping them to better understand the science that surrounds them. School groups are reserving spaces on our campus in hopes that the 2021-2022 academic year will bring with it a return to field trips for students from Milford, Philadelphia, Newark, and New York City. The Center has developed an exciting calendar of events in order to engage the public in science. I don't want to spoil the surprise, but PEEC will hit an important milestone in 2022. As we move past our "honeymoon" period and shift into our "golden years" for environmental education in the Poconos, I am sure that I can come up with **FIFTY** excellent reasons that you should visit PEEC this year!

Helping the Community

In coordination with Greater Pike Community Foundation and Pocono Pro Foods, along with local business donations from Tucker Silk Mill. in Easton PA, PEEC was able to provide hundreds of meals for Pike County Meals on Wheels during 2020.

We also received a generous donation of 8,000 bagels from Pocono Pro Foods, which we helped distribute to lo's Outreach, LYF Outreach, Police, Fire, and Ambulance Corps in Monroe and Pike Counties, and to our Delaware Valley Schools for students receiving free and reduced lunches.







Fast Facts

Volunteers: The Trail Stewards were able to volunteer from August-November with approximately 40 hours/person. During that time, some of their projects included:

- Installing green pavers at the entrance of the Two Ponds Trail.
- Replacing warped boards on the spillway bridge at Front Pond.
- Continued clean-up and work at George W. Child's Park.

Public Programs: 1,275 participants attended the programs which were able to continue in 2020. Our 19 grant-funded Bridge the Gap programs totaled 212 attendees.





Growing Green

For the 9th year, PEEC continued our partnership with Easterseals of Eastern Pennsylvania and Camp Growing Green. For the first time ever, camp was entirely virtual. Campers joined PEEC staff each day over Zoom for a variety of lessons and games. Campers met PEEC's EcoZone animals, planted window-sill gardens in cups, went on scavenger hunts, and even sung songs around a campfire. This allowed the 32 campers in the program to learn from and experience nature in a new and safe way.



Summer Camp

Summer Camp for 2020 brought our largest year for summer camp on record. PEEC hosted 12 weeks of camp starting in mid-June and going until Labor Day, serving a grand total of 363 campers. COVID-19 safety precautions allowed PEEC to operate with a mostly "normal" year as campers remained socially distanced and masked-up on-site. PEEC welcomed 85 new campers to the PEEC family as our outdoor camps allowed many families a chance at normalcy during the pandemic. The Volunteer Counselor program stayed strong with 7 Volunteer Counselors in 2020.

Education & Operations Updates

PEEC in the Classroom - Fall 2020 also launched our "PEEC Into the Classroom" Outreach initiative for both in-person and online learning in topics like Animal Survival, Native Plants, Geology and Water Quality. In the remaining months of the year, 40 outreach lessons were taught in 7 different schools. Seven hundred forty-five elementary to high school students received either virtual or in-person outreach lessons.
