



Sci-Q COVID Protocols

- All campers will be screened for symptoms and have their temperature taken upon arrival at PEEC, and every morning during their stay.
- Masks are mandatory indoors at all times and outdoors when within 6 feet of another person. The only exceptions are when campers are in their beds, shower, or sitting and eating in the Dining Hall.
- We removed half the tables from the Dining Hall and each table only has 4 chairs to spread campers out when eating. (The tables usually seat 8 people)
- All food is prepared and plated by PEEC staff behind the line. We will have pre-made salads at lunch and dinner and single-serving cereals and fruit cups at breakfast to avoid the use of the salad and breakfast bars. Everything that can be single serving, is single serving.
- Campers are assigned bunks in the cabins, with at least 1 free bunk between every camper. Every camper is in a lower bunk, and we ask each camper to bring extra sheets to hang from the top bunk in order to make a barrier between them and their neighbors.
- All buildings and surfaces used during the day are cleaned before being disinfected and then sprayed with virucide from a backpack fogger. The virucide is left to dry on surfaces before the building opens the following day. Special attention is given to high contact surfaces such as restrooms, light switches, door knobs, etc.
- If an individual gets sick while at PEEC, the individual will be moved to an isolation cabin. We will assess symptoms and activate our COVID-19 response protocol, which includes any necessary medical communications with local, state and federal agencies.
- Current American Camp Association guidelines discourage field trips and off-site activities for camps. We are preparing to run a fully on-site program like we did successfully in 2020. If guidelines change and we decide to schedule off-site field trips, participants will be notified.
