



Summer Day Camp Code of Conduct

Please read the following Code of Conduct for PEEC Summer Day Camp carefully and acknowledge below.

1. The camper and their parent/guardian agree to abide by the rules and regulations set by PEEC for the health, safety, and welfare of PEEC, its camp, campers, and staff. The parent/guardian has reviewed and agrees to information and policies outlined in all other PEEC camp documentation.
2. PEEC reserves the right to send home a camper whose physical condition, conduct or influence is deemed unsatisfactory or inimical to the best interests of PEEC, its camp, campers, and staff. In such instances no refund will be given.
3. Stealing, damaging, or destroying campers, staff, or PEEC property or facilities will result in the removal of campers from the program. By registering my child for camp, I acknowledge that this is at the discretion of PEEC.
4. No reduction or allowance of tuition will be made for late arrivals, missed days, or early withdrawal of campers from a session, regardless of reason.
5. We suggest that you consult your insurance agent to make sure that your child's equipment and personal belongings are covered while in transit or at camp. PEEC is not responsible for such loss or damage by fire, theft, laundry, etc.
6. Campers and their parent/guardian may not physically or emotionally endanger themselves, other campers, staff, or other persons at or associated with PEEC and its camp program.
7. I grant permission for my child to be taken off PEEC's campus for camp-approved activities.

All campers and parents must agree to PEEC's behavioral policies in order to attend camp.

Our rules are based on respect for the safety and well-being of the PEEC campers, families, and staff. PEEC staff will work closely with families to identify solutions and support the camper's success. However, in the event that a child's failure to adhere to any of the above outlined points poses a direct threat to safety or an undue burden on staff that cannot be reasonably mitigated, PEEC reserves the right to evaluate continued participation on a case-by-case basis. By registering my child for camp, I acknowledge that this is at the discretion of camp management.
